In addition, those who purchase an offerings set from just THB 60 up will have a chance to win a sacred object that promotes prosperity and fortune. Entrance is free of charge and Thais, foreign residents and tourists are welcome. The event will be held from 16th to 25th May and is open daily, 10:00 – 19:00 hrs.

Ratchaprasong Cultural Centre (RCC), or the Museum of Asian Cultures, with the cooperation of Amarin Plaza shopping center, Kraft Space Co. Ltd., and the Buddha Dharma Relics Museum have set aside an area of over 500 square meters, on the 3rd floor of Amarin Plaza, as a gathering place for religious art, as well as Buddha images and relics of the Buddha and those of various Buddhist sects.
