

SPU Received 2 Awards from “Taipei International Invention Show & Technomart”

Students from the School of Engineering; Mr. Nattapong Kongmalai and Mr. Settawichok Nilnawarat with an advisor Dr. Wanayuth San-ngern - Head of Mechatronics Engineering Department, Sripatum University, participated in the invention competition as part of “Taipei International Invention Show & Technomart” (INST 2015). This event, held from 1 - 3 October 2015 in Taipei, Taiwan, was organized by Taiwan External Trade Development Council. Among the 980 inventions from 13 countries, SPU team received 2 awards for their invention which is a robot suit for lower body that helps disabled people walk.
