A journey follows: from the north, sizzling Hanoi fishcakes; from imperial Hue, bun bo Hue noodle soup and savoury crepes; from Hoi An, caramelised pork belly glazed to perfection; and finally, for those who dare, Chef Le's signature dish of spicy curried frog. Finish your feast with one final indulgence - grilled banana in coconut milk with crushed peanuts or a steaming cup of famous egg coffee.

Chef Le's hand-crafted dishes will be available throughout the fortnight at Nest, with an exclusive wine dinner scheduled for 14th July. With nine restaurants and bars spread across two islands, Niyama Private Islands Maldives is a gourmand's dreamland. Dine by a bonfire, at water's edge, or 6 m below the ocean's surface. Navigate a world of flavours from African bush game to Mediterranean lightness to the bounty of the Indian Ocean.
